


To ensure efficient and effective use of this platform and smooth online classes, please make sure that you have the following:

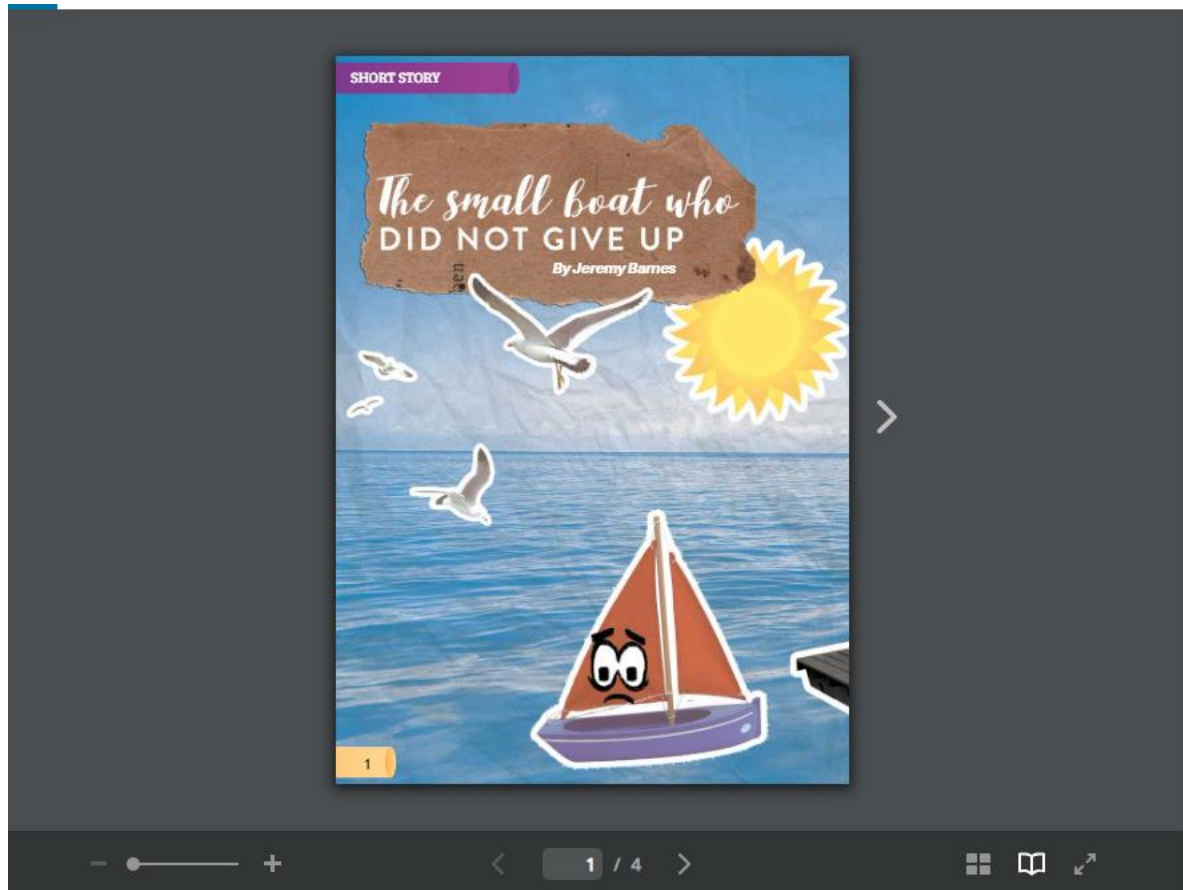
2. You will then be directed to SunagoLearn page. You can view the classes or courses which you are enrolled in as shown in the image below. Click on the **JustRead course**.





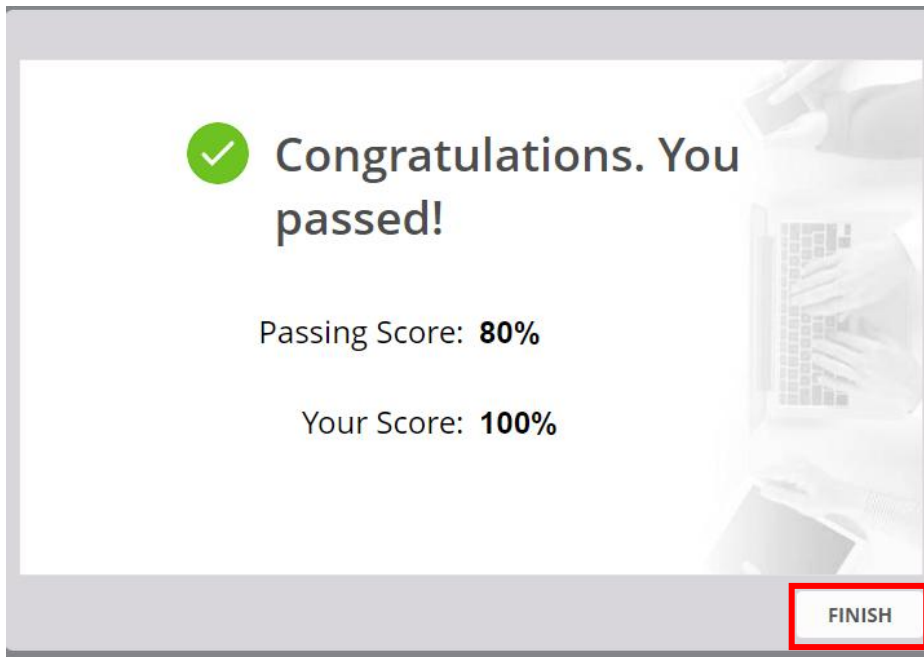
